
MARCH IS READING MONTH!

In honor of Dr. Seuss' birthday, March is designated as National Reading Month – a month to motivate Americans of all ages to read every day. Reading is fun and has many benefits, regardless of your age. It's a key component of education and professional development. It also has immediate and long-lasting health benefits such as increased cognitive function, memory, vocabulary, empathy and decreased levels of stress.

READING IS BONDING TIME!

Reading aloud to children from birth positively impacts their language development and literacy skills. It is also a great opportunity to bond with your child and can provide warm, memorable experiences for both of you.

- Let your child turn the book's pages. It's OK if they skip pages, or like a few pages better than others. You just want your child to get used to touching books
- Ask open-ended questions and encourage your child to describe the pictures he sees.
- It's okay to read the same book over and over again if that's what your child wants! Repetition helps children learn new concepts and become familiar with words.
