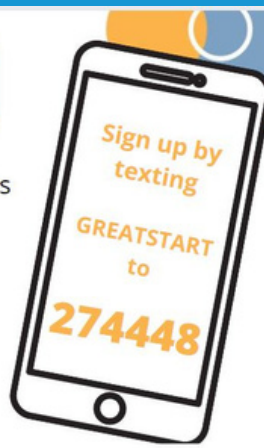

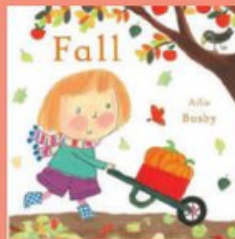


## Fall for reading!

By: Allie Busby

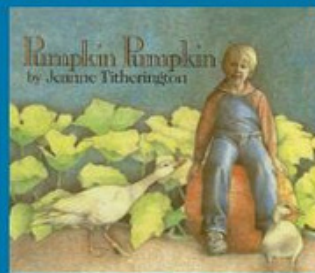
