Since 1973, P.E.O. has been helping women of various ages in the U.S. and Canada with need-based grants. If your education was interrupted and you need to return to school to enhance your job skills or care for your family, we're here for you.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be recommended by a local chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood
- Must be a woman enrolled in a certification or degree program from an accredited institution and who has not already earned a master's degree or above
- Must have had at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime in her adult life
- Must be within 18 consecutive months of completing her educational program

GRANT DETAILS

- Maximum grant amount is \$4,000
- Grant monies are intended as a grant-in-aid for education-related expenses such as tuition, books, supplies, transportation, childcare while in class, required uniforms, testing fees and equipment/tools
- One-time award
