



Michigan Public Health Code requires any student entering Kindergarten, 7th grade or a new school district in MI to have an upto-date immunization history or a valid waiver on file.

If you fall into any of these categories and your child is not up-to-date you will be receiving a letter before school starts indicating what immunizations your student needs and where to get them, or a waiver.

If you would like to insure your device, the payment is due no later than October 1st.
