I met with Howard at the High School regarding a bed bug found on a student today. I was able to verify that it was a bed bug via a picture. Howard and I made visits to rooms where the student had been today. The object of these visits was to install active bed bug monitors in areas of potential activity. While visiting rooms 113, 202, 205, and 206 we were able to make contact with teaching staff. The teaching staff in each room were asked about bed bug activity. The staff in rooms 113, 202, and 205 have not seen any bed bugs. Room 206 was the room where the specimen was caught and discarded today. Please see the location list for trap placements in these rooms.

During my visit I was also able to check the traps in the Media Center. These traps have been in place for a week. No bed bugs were caught amongst the 6 active monitors in the Media Center. No new activity has been reported.

Summary: Much like the initial issue in the Media Center, this new issue was the result of a bedbug being brought to school. With the results of the trap inspection in the Media Center, and through thorough inspections, we can say confidently that there is not an established population. Please have custodial staff continue to follow the bedbug best practices/general cleaning procedures. We will continue to monitor our traps through the end of the school year.
